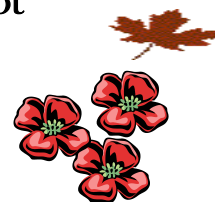
Waterloo Cenotaph

Recognized as the turning point of the WWII—the Battle of Britain showed the strength of the Allies and ultimately led them to victory.

The valiant fighter pilots conquered a far superior force in numbers, but they paid a heavy price for their victory in the skies over London. British Prime Minister Churchill recognized his 'young knights of the air' with his famous speech—"Never in the field of human conflict was so much owed by so many to so few."
