## HOUSE RULES

1. Members are accorded the facilities of the Wing during scheduled hours or by appointment.
2. Hats, coats, overshoes, etc., must be left in the cloakroom, before the member enters the lounge. No animals, birds, etc., except Seeing Eye dogs, are allowed in the Wing.
3. Members are requested to register and sign-in their guest(s) in the Guest Book.
4. Members are responsible for their guest's actions and deportment and are liable for any damage caused by themselves or their guests.
5. Members and guests are expected to conduct themselves in a manner becoming a member of the Association. For example:
  - a) Suitable attire is required at all times; Blues and Greys are recommended for the General meetings.
  - b) Abusive or profane language will not be tolerated.
  - c) Drunkenness will not be tolerated.
6. Members and guests shall adhere strictly to all Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) regulations pertinent to the Bar operation; the Duty Bar Steward shall enforce such AGCO regulations, as well as any Wing House Policies, including, but not limited to the following:
  - a) No one under the age of 19 years will be served liquor or tobacco products.
  - b) Unauthorized persons will not be permitted behind the bar.
  - c) Opened alcoholic beverages are not to be carried in or out of the Wing, except to the licenced patio area.
  - d) All orders for liquor must be served before 2 a.m. All signs of liquor must be cleared 45 minutes after the end time on the licence.
7. Members and/or their guests will leave the Wing when requested to do so by the Bar Steward or by any member of the Executive Council. Failure to do so renders the member liable to suspension or expulsion in accordance with section 4.4 of the Wing by-laws.
8. Under normal circumstances head gear is not to be worn in the Wing Lounge except:
  - a) The Wing Sgt.-at-Arms and the Wing Colour Party.
  - b) When the headgear is a part of a costume at a Wing social event.
9. Recommendations, suggestions, and/or complaints, in writing and duly signed, should be forwarded to the Wing Executive Council, or brought to the Floor at a General Meeting. Complaints are not to be directed to the Bar Steward.

*Full co-operation by all members of the Wing and their guests is expected. These regulations, having been duly approved by the general membership, are the rules of 404 K-W Wing 404 R.C.A.F.A.*
