Due to AFAC National requirements, a late fee will be charged for submissions received after June 30th. Consecutive years of service are also affected by late payments.

Past service in the Armed Forces is not a requirement to join. Every member must subscribe to the aims and objectives of the Air Force Association of Canada (incorporating the Royal Canadian Air Force Association). Certain aviation affiliations may immediately qualify a new member as a Regular Member. To keep our wing viable we need to bring in new members. 




