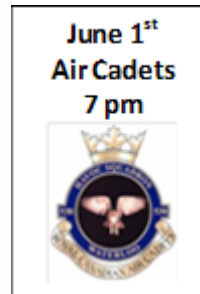

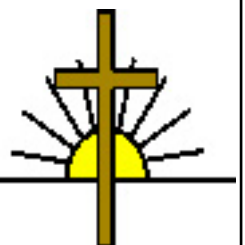


William "Bill" Frost passed away April 30th. 2015.
